

IMPORTANT ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS

Every faculty member is urged to follow through on these matters. Your cooperation will be appreciated.

1. Follow carefully the Examination Schedule. Each exam is scheduled for a period of two hours and will begin on time.

Admit to Class cards and Grade Sheets are to be turned in to the Registrar's Office as completed, not to exceed 48 hours after the examination. All grades must be in the Registrar's Office by 9:00 A.M. Monday, June 2.

Assign numbers to students and post grades promptly for the information of students.

Any variation from the Exam schedule must be cleared with the Registrar.

2. You have in hand the list of Seniors and Graduate Students who are scheduled to receive degrees June 1. These are to be given whatever examination the teachers think best and the grades on these students must be in the Registrar's Office at 9:00 A.M., Wednesday, May 28th.

3. Registration for the Summer Term will include two days, June 2 and 3. Monday and until noon Tuesday returning students will be registered. New students will register Tuesday afternoon.

Registration Instruction sheets will be available shortly. It is very important that these be followed by both faculty and students. Each Dean and Department Head will be responsible for getting staff members to serve during registration

For this Summer the regular Course Card will be used for primary listing of courses. The left side of the Matriculation Card will be used for first term classes and the right side for the second term. We will register students for both terms at the opening of the first term. This will save much time and labor even if there are a few changes later.
