I have been in West Texas and New Mexico and picked up the following information on meteors, which I pass along to you with no guarantee:

Mr. R. DeChicchis, Petroleum Building, Midland, Texas says that he gave pieces of the Pike Spring (20 miles southeast of Midland) meteor to the geologists in offices of Marland Oil Company and Pure Oil Company, San Angelo, Texas. I suggest that you call D. D. Christner of the Marland and R. A. Lidell with the Pure Oil Company, both here in Fort Worth. I also suggest that you send DeChicchis a copy of your meteor crater map; he said he would like to have a copy.
