Dear Mr. Konnig,

You may be interested to know of a new find of the Admire pallasite in Lyon County, Kansas, the original finds being about 1890. The new fragment, which came to light last October, weighs 69 lbs. and is in good condition. There is no decomposition inside, though the crust is of the usual brown, oxidized material.

The specimen, which I have examined in some detail, including spectrographically, was discovered by Mr. Elmer R. Stinson, Route 1, Admire, Kansas, the farmer who owns the property. He would probably be willing to dispose of it if you were interested in considering a purchase. I told Ward's of Rochester, N.Y., about it, and this specimen is now in their catalog.

Dr. W.S. Houston, of Kansas State College, Manhattan, told me of your collection of meteorites.
