The meteorite which I purchased from Mr. Norwood weighed 15.5 kg. and as nearly as I could learn at the time it was found near enough to the Adrian, Texas, stone to be a part of the same fall. Since both are very old and show the same general structure I tentatively placed it in that fall. I've not gotten around to a more complete study of it.

The location is No.2 on my map of Texas, p.25 of the NININGER COLLECTION OF METEORITES. It is a chondrite.
