Dear Mr. Norwood:

I was recently in the region of Hereford, Texas, about 25 miles northwest thereof, at the old D ranch searching for an alleged meteorite.

This was reported to me by a Mrs. Charlie Owens, now at Vernon, Texas, who lived in that region about 1922 or 1923. She remembers coming upon this rock one day with her husband and said they could not break it and that it was too heavy to move, which makes it sound very much like a rather substantial stone or iron meteorite partly buried.

I am writing you because I understood that you worked up at the D for a while for Mr. Williams, and I am wondering if you ever heard of any one finding this object or know anything about it. It was supposed to be about 2 miles south and just a little east from the old original ranch headquarters on the D. A stamped envelope is enclosed for your reply. If you ever run into any meteorites, I am interested and would appreciate hearing from you. I enclose a circular on the subject which may tell you something about them.
