Dear Sir:

I have a number of moderate sized specimens of
Pueblito de Allende but am interested in your offer of some smaller
ones. Could you send me a range of sizes from the $\frac{1}{2}$ x $\frac{3}{4}$ to
 $\frac{3}{4}$ x 1 and 1 x 1, say about 15 pieces altogether?

I have not been able to learn anything more about
the Nutwood Downs locality but have asked Dr. Henderson at the U. S.
National Museum about it. I would like to have one more of these
and will take one of your largest pieces.

Finally, can you select a moldavite for me that
might make a good stone for a ring? I would want one not too large
because my hand is small and also for the reason that I hope for a
piece not too thick that might show some color--a sort of natural
cabochon not too high domed that could be mounted without doing any
work on it. I would want to use it in its natural condition. If
it was somewhat irregular in shape that would not hurt, but if it
could be nearly round or oval I think that would help. I hope you
can pick out one in the $\frac{1}{2}$ to $\frac{5}{8}$ range.
