


Mr Star AOK Sept 30-1945

Dear Mr. Monnig:-

We thank you for having written us about this meteor that fell near Atoka. - I've seen stars shoot toward the earth many times at night but I never saw a sight like this in daytime. - I got the impression it was not more than 5 or 10 miles from us. Looked like it fell in a field, west of us. - We rode a mile from the spot where we saw it and still saw the smoke or train and it looked as if it were far off in the sky. - When we last saw the smoke it had this shape:- 

We thought we could see it as it exploded:- that's why my wife thought it was a "plane"? Bright spots seem to fly eastward upon the explosion: We saw it high (don't know how high) - in the air - But the speed of its fall was terrific - We will be interested in getting any other information you can give us yours truly
