Dear Sir:

I saw in this morning's Star Telegram where you were seeking the route of the meteor that was seen 7:30 P.M.

Monday.

I saw the meteor while traveling between Bonham and Telephone, Tex. At that time I was about 17 miles northeast of Bonham. From my point of view it seemed to be traveling north. I saw it just a few seconds before it went out. It looked as though it were about six inches in diameter and the flame from it was about three feet high. It went out very suddenly, but

the smoke could be seen
for five or ten minutes).
