At long last I have got a map of the Belle Plaine region and I enclose two copies. Altho you have already given me the location of the find of the stone I got from you as 2 miles east and 4 south of Belle Plaine, I would like to have it marked on one of these maps and returned to me.

Could you also mark hereon the location of the second stone of some 65 pounds which you found some years later? Mark it No. 2.

I had hoped the U. S. G. S. had a new and recent editbn of a map of this region but I find this 1887 survey is the latest available. There is a Belle Plaine, Kan., sheet of 1955 and I have two copies of it here but it corners less than 2 miles SE of Belle Plaine and presumably would not include the locality involved.

Keep one copy of the maps I am sending for yourself. And now I hope you will again consider letting me have the second stone. I will make the same offer as before, of \$3 a pound plus freight and packing charges. I will surely appreciate hearing from you about this.
