

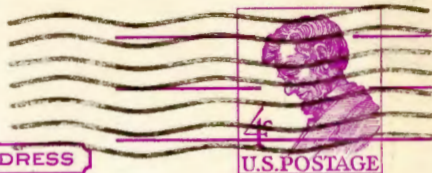

Mason did get fragment of 63 fall from KU and piece of 1957 fall from Henderson...Mason says the x ray spectra seem identical. So both specimens may be from same fall. Can you send me photo of your Belle Plaine plus a checked weight so I can further clear up the identification?
