Dear Sir:

In a telephone call from Mr. H. H. Mininger of Sedona, Ariz., last night, we were discussing the fireball of Sep. 9 at about 10.08 p.m. He kindly gave me your name and address and said you had reported an excellent observation of this object.

Some associates have joined me here in making a survey of the path of this object, and we think we have determined it pretty well, having traveled practically all around it and secured numbers of observation from this region.

However, your observation would be most welcome to shed further light on the subject and perhaps enable us to correct or more sharply define some conclusion. Should you care to write me any observational data you have, we would appreciate it.

We have located the sub-final region sufficiently well that we have secured one small meteorite that was retrieved and are working the adjoining regions in hopes of securing others. The meteorite is of a type that shatters easily and there are presumably hundreds of small fragments. Getting them found is a different matter.
