Dear Sir:

I want to send a circular on meteorites and a mimeographed letter to all the postal patrons of Route 1 out of Bells, Texas, which I understand is the only route you have.

It is my understanding that I can send these for 3 cents each in bundles of 50 unsealed with a postage meter precancellation from here.

Please advise me if this is correct and how many patrons are on that route.

I am doing this in connection with the fireball that appeared the night of Sept. 9th just after 10 p.m. Our investigation shows that this ended in a great burst about over the Bells-Savoy region, perhaps a little to the north, and fragments of the meteorite should be scattered over that region.

They are solid black rocks, not as heavy as some meteorites, and looking like pieces of charcoal with a melted crust.
