Dear Mrs. Coleman:

Thank you for writing me about the fireball of Sept. 9th. I think I would very much like to interview your musband on the spot where he observed the meteor, and get a measured observation from him.

This would involved only his pointing as carefully as he could to the points in the sky where he first and last saw the fireball, and can all be done in about three minutes.

I hope to be in Sherman again soon, possible next Saturday or Sunday, and will try to phone in advance and get an appointment with Mr. Coleman.

No meteorite has been yet found, so far as I know. Pieces picked up at McKinney were fragments of slag a little boy found in a driveway. I have not seen pieces reported from Bonham but that city was not under the path and it is not likely any meteorites from this fireball could have fallen there.
