Dear Mr. Monnig:


The last few months were a rat race, with Apollo 11 papers, meetings, flu, and whatnot. Let me report to you, belatedly, that the Bells sample weighed 95.0 mg. So you did alright without a gram scale! We have loaded half of it in our mass spectrometer, along with 26 other samples, and expect to measure it within the next 2-3 months. We can then decide what the best use will be for the other half.

Bells arrived a little too late for inclusion in our comprehensive study of carbonaceous chondrites, of which I recently sent you a copy. But there is bound to be a short sequel to it, as a few new carbonaceous chondrites have fallen within the past year.

Will keep you posted on our results.
