This fresh new heavily fusion crusted LL6 meteorite is one of the largest stones from the recent Feb. 11, 2002 witnessed fall at Bensour, Morocco. News of the arrival of Bensour and many of the actual specimens began to spread throughout the meteorite community like wild-fire almost immediately after the fall. The amazing aspect of the entire Bensour story is that this meteorite was seen to fall in an area inhabited by experienced nomadic meteorite hunters. Most of the meteorites from this ~45 kilo fall were recovered within hours of their arrival on earth and many individual specimens now grace collections worldwide. Very rarely does a meteorite go directly from space into collections in a matter of weeks. It is a collectors dream to own a piece of the freshest, newest meteorite on earth and Bensour has made that dream come true for quite a few collectors!
