Dear Mr Kimberly; I had some luck yesterday in the maize field across road from your place. I found a 110-120 lb. meteorite at the west end of the field, a little north east of the windmill.

Your neighbor south of you tellshe found a 35 lb meteorite south of the windmill along the fence some fifty years ago.

I have a letter from a Mr.Monnig of Fort Worth, Texas offering us \$1.00 per pound for the two smaller meteorites. The weights were 220 and 357 lbs making a total of 577 lbs.

This was the weights with the rust, scale and clay on the stones.

I would suggest we call the weights as 570 lbs. This would we taking off seven pounds for waste. There could be a difference of a pound or two on wagon scale weight of the small one.

This would be a price of \$570.00 or \$285.00 for each of us.

If this is satisfactory let me know and I will write Mr.Monnig to send check. Mr Monnig was very good in promising to let me keep the meteorites here for couple of montghs for display.
