As the grade report is to be made on each student very soon this word of guidance is offered. If all teachers will grade in keeping with the grading system published in the catalog we will speak the same language so far as grading is concerned.

A - Reserved for exceptional work

B - Implies superior work

C = Means medium work
D = Means inferior work

F - Means failure

- I Means incomplete (must be removed within thirty days of the semester immediately following or it becomes an F). The fee for removing an "I" grade is \$2.00. Where a teacher gives an "I" grade written word must accompany the grade sheet indicating the reason for the "I".
  - N = "No grade" (Is not to be used at the close of semester)
    WP Used when student drops a course while making a passing
    grade. This means an official drop, not just quitting
    the course.
  - WF = Used when a student drops a course after the first six weeks and is failing at the time he drops the course

Please be accurate in assigning grades for every inaccuaracy entails unnecessary work in the offices and causes embarrassment to all conserned. All grades must be turned in within 48 hours after the final exam period for a given class.
