

Dear Oscar:

This acknowledges receipt of a payment from you of \$1,500.00 in cash as the final payment for the two large Tishomingo irons. You paid me \$500.00 as evidenced by a memorandum we signed June 8, 1969 and later made a cash payment of another \$500.00 May 24, 1969.

The agreed price is \$2,500.00, and this will include one half of the two smaller irons found in the same hole with the larger meteorites. I have kept half of the smallest piece which originally weighed about 2 pounds 6 ounces and you already have the other half of this. The other piece, of about 5 $\frac{1}{2}$  pounds, is now in the U. S. National Museum in Washington being studied, but you agree to get approximately half of this returned to me.
