I'm pleased to hear of your "DePaul" work. I'd guess our average iron from there is 4% or less. Many of them have reacted considerably & they seem to do worse when broed up. I think chlorine is relevant and keeps working on them.

I am not familiar with the two farms you named but have the ground in premise the "strewer field" lies mostly east of Shadovlands. I never could get precise locations from most of the natives - they apparently feared we would come with their "spots" and cut them out.

There are some fragments of old iron tools or tractor parts that you have to be careful not to buy. You can generally tell by the shape.

I have made a total of 4 trips on the Oct 18<sup>th</sup> festival but probably won't try again until in January. Will let you know. No word from up there. But I have each been very busy in our work.
