METEORITE IS FOUND IN LULING FIELD

LULING, Tex., July 16.—What is believed to be parts of a fallen meteor were plowed up on a farm near Luling this week by C. C. Perry.

Two pieces which weighed about 150 pounds were found about 75 feet apart, partly buried in the earth. Inside of one of the pieces was found what appeared to be a chunk of brass weighing one pound and six ounces.

On the under side of the meteor the sandy soil was fused with the metallic, slag-appearing substance.
