- l. It is very important that Deans and Department Heads charged with the responsibility of keeping Petition Sheets up to date turn these over to the Registrar not later than June 15, that plenty of time may be given to checking.
- 2. Where at all possible talk these over with the student in each instance for a mutual understanding, if you have not already done so.
- 3. A list of names should accompany the Petition Sheets for checking purposes.

THE SUMMER ENROLLMENT

- l. Registration moved off rather smoothly in the new location and a fine cooperative spirit was manifested by both students and faculty.
- 2. Enrollment figures will appear in the Skiff if at all possible to make the count by the time of publication.
- 3. Make doubly sure that all who are attending a given class are properly enrolled for that class. It will save distressing problems later for all concerned.
