

CLOSING THE FIRST SUMMER TERM

All returning students whose programs are being changed for any reason either by drops and adds, or withdrawals, must appear on the 17th within these assigned hours regardless of initial letter and clear matters needing attention. This can be done speedily provided all cooperate fully.

Classes for the second term will begin Tuesday, July 18.

No new registrations and no adds can be received after Thursday, July 20. These should all be cared for on the 17th.

New students will register in the Auditorium on the 17th along with the above program of registration.
