REGISTRATION ITEMS

1. The set-up for the Second Summer Term proved to be the most efficient way to handle the registration in view of a heavy influx of new students together with adds, drops, and changes. If you have any ideas regarding a better way to do it give us a letter offering suggestions.
2. Judging from the number of new students entering July 17 the final figures on registration will run approximately the same as last summer. Detailed word will be given in next week's Faculty Bulletin. (a continued story, suspense)
3. Registrations will positively close Thursday, July 20. Also this is the last day to add a course, or process a change of section. Drops may continue, of course, but please urge your students who drop out to do so officially. A student does not drop by simply quitting a course. Give the bookkeepers a chance!
4. Please check your class to make sure all who are in attendance are enrolled for that particular course and section. Often students wander into a class and pay but little attention to the number and section. You can check by calling out the course, number, section and asking for a show of hands. If anyone is in doubt check the student's little pink enrollment card.
5. Preliminary rolls will be mailed to the teachers at the earliest possible date, possible late next week. In the meantime, check as above suggested.
