SCHEDULE OF FINAL EXAMINATIONS * FALL SEMESTER January 21-26, 1952

Instructions

1. Each examination is scheduled for a two hour period and should begin and close promptly.

2. Instructors will turn in their grades to their department heads (in duplicate) within 24 hours after each examination. The last grades are to reach department heads not later than 11:00 A.M. Saturday the 26th. and the Registrar's Office not later than noon that same day. The deans are to gather the grades from their department heads each day during Examination Week and on the same day turn them to the Registrar's Office. The deans will retain one copy for reference. By following this schedule the IBM can process grades in time to avoid congestion during registration and provide grades for the days of registration.

3. Teachers are urged to post grades outside their offices as grades are assigned that their students may have the information promptly.

4. There is no special schedule for those completing degree requirements in January. "Rush" requests for transcripts will be cared for individually.
