Dear Faculty Member:

This week, March 3-7, is the week set aside for Texas Christian University's first Campus Chest Drive.

Having a goal of \$3150, the drive pulls into one concentrated effort all of the charity fund raising drives on the campus. This is the only time this year that students will be called upon to give money for others.

The Deans' Council has given the Chest committee permission to enter class rooms at 9 a. m., Wednesday for the purpose of making four-minute "sales talks" on the drive. Approximately fifty students are being trained to make these class-room presentations of the Campus Chest.

Precise and comprehensive, these talks will not interfere with more than the allotted four minutes of your class hour. Because of the large number of class rooms to be covered by our speakers, however, the speaker assigned to your class room could come either during the first four minutes of the hour or the last four.

Also, the Deans' Council has given the speakers, some of whom have classes at that period, permission to be out of their classes for the two speech periods at the beginning and at the end of the class session. In making assignments to the speakers, care has been taken to assign them classes that are not far from their own class rooms. They should not then miss more than ten or twelve minutes of their class.

This is a project which could make the TCU campus grow. The Campus Chest Committee thanks you for your cooperation and aid in making the venture a success. Solicitation from the faculty will take place Monday and Tuesday, and we are sure that you will help support this drive.
