



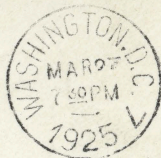
Thank you for the key to Fort Worth,
