

# CARBO

The pictured specimen weighs 191 grams and is classified as an Iron (IID)

A mass of 1000 pounds was found in 1923 on the Alamo ranch, 40 miles W. Of Carbo, Sonora district, Mexico. Note the stunning Widmanstätten pattern on the face of this nicely polished, acid etched slice.

As is the case with most meteorites, Carbo is named after the nearest town with a post office, to where it fell or was discovered.
