Dear Mr. Sheppard:

In response to an inquiry of mine about aerial photographs you kindly gave me the numbers of four which would cover an area I had inquired about, and I thank you greatly for the forms and information contained in your letter answering mine.

I must trouble you on two more points:

1. I need to cover only an area about a mile square centering on the cross with the dotted circle around it on the attached sketch from a State Highway Planning Survey map. I doubt if I would need all four of the pictures you listed, which were CRI-2V-129; CRI-2V-31; CRI-2V-177; and CRI-2V-179. Could you tell me now which of these I would need; or, if you prefer, indicate the boundaries of these on my sketch and return it to me for my decision.

2. You gave me the correct street address of the Western Laboratory in Salt Lake City, but the instructions on the reverse of Form-~~005~~-441 indicate Texas maps should be ordered from the Eastern Laboratory at Washington. Please advise which one is correct.
