Several months ago you came to my mother's house at 408 W. Grand in Comanche, and looked at what we thought might be a meteorite. We have found a rather strange sunken hole in the ground not far from here. When we noticed this place was about a month or so ago-- and at that time of course it had rained and there was mud and water in the bottom of the pit. This place is about 4ft. or 5ft. across. It has not been there too long, for you can tell it had some vegetation (briars) growing on it when it sunk. We have thought about digging down into it when the water dries up. It is right on top of an old rocky hill North and East of our place about 2 mile. This may be another wild goose chase but when you need some fresh air and country sunshine-- we will take you and show you-- if you are interested.
