I am a collector of meteorites, and the man who used to live in your house, Mr. Carroll Schulz, had a piece of one his father had found. It might be in any of your flower beds, or in some odd place such as next to the fence, under the house or some steps, or out in the alley if there is one in back of the house. It was probably thrown away at the time as being of no interest.
