September 14-17, 1953

Registration is a cooperative undertaking requiring great care on the part of students, faculty and all concerned. Thoughfulness and accuracy at the time of registration will make it unnecessary to make changes later. Please follow instructions.

I. NEW STUDENTS

- 1. All new students are required to provide the following items before registration can begin:
 - (1) An Application for Admission.
 - (2) A Personal Data Sheet.

(3) A Health Record and Physical Examination Report.

(4) An Acceptable Transcript of Credits from the last school attended.

Only those who have provided all four of these items by Saturday, September 12, can be considered during the regular period of registration for new students. Otherwise there will be much inconvenience and delay.

New Students shall be cleared through the Admissions Office prior to registration. All materials necessary to clear your entrance, including the forms supplied by the Admissions Office, and your transcripts should be in before September 14. If you have not been able to do this please contact the Admissions Office.

- 2. All new students entering T. C. U. for the first time will assemble in the Ed Landreth Auditorium in the Fine Arts Building, 9:00 a. m., Monday, September 14.
