

REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS - TEXAS CHRISTIAN UNIVERSITY

SPRING SEMESTER — JANUARY 29, 30, 31 — 1953

By following the registration procedure outlined below an orderly, efficient and satisfying outcome will follow. Thank you for your cooperation!

I. NEW STUDENTS

1. All new students are required to receive clearance from the Admissions Office before they can enroll.
2. All new students entering TCU for the first time this spring will meet in the Little Theater, 9:00 A. M. Thursday, January 29.
3. New Freshmen will continue with the following program:

Thursday

- 9:00 A. M. Little Theater.
- 9:30 A. M. R. O. T. C. Meeting.
- 10:00 A. M. Testing Period.
- 1:30 P. M. Little Theater.
- 2:30 P. M. Testing Period.

Friday

- 9:00 A. M. Testing Period.
- 11:00 A. M. Lecture—Little Theater.
- 1:30 P. M. Counseling.

4. Registration of All New Students will begin in the Science Building, 8:00 A. M. Saturday and continue until 11:30 A. M.

II. RETURNING STUDENTS

1. Returning students, whether they have attended TCU in the fall of 1952, or at some previous time, will report to the Science Building on the following schedule:

III. BRITE COLLEGE OF THE BIBLE STUDENTS

1. Graduate students in religion are to complete all items of registration, January 26-28 in the Dean's Office.
2. Classes will begin January 29.

IV. EVENING COLLEGE STUDENTS

1. Students registering exclusively in the Evening College will report to the Library, 6:00 to 9:00 P. M., Thursday, January 29, and Friday, January 30.
2. Students who take part of their work in day classes and desire to register for one class in the Evening will follow the routine outlined for day students in column one.
3. Evening College students who plan to enter the day school must contact the Registrar's Office.
4. Evening College classes begin February 2.

V. GRADUATE STUDENTS

1. All graduate students entering TCU for the first time must clear application and transcript requirements with the Dean not later than January 25.
2. Registration is held both during the regular day and evening periods outlined above. Graduate students need not observe the alphabetical order outlined.

VI. TO REGISTER

1. Begin at the north end of the Science Building.
2. Next, go to the Library, get your counselor's help with course selections, have the various departments approve these selections, then have your Major Professor and your Dean approve your cards.
3. Veterans will then go to Room 209 in the Administration Building.
4. Go to the Business Office.

3. Last date to register, change, or add, February 11.
