REGISTRATION BEGINS IN THE SCIENCE BUILDING, Monday, June 7

The Registration procedure will be streamlined for speed, accuracy and convenience of all concerned. Both new and returning students will appear for registration on the following last-name-initial-letter routine—

Monday, June 7

8:00 to 10:00 A.M. A, B, C, D, E,
10:00 to 12:00 A.M. F, G, H, I, J, K,
1:30 to 3:00 P.M. L, M, N, O, P, Q, R,
3:00 to 4:30 P.M. S, T, U, V, W, X, Y, Z.

I. NEW STUDENTS

1. All new students are required to clear through the Admissions Office before they can enroll.
2. Registration of all new students will follow the routine given above and under paragraph "V."

II. RETURNING STUDENTS

1. Returning students regardless of the date previously enrolled in T. C. U. will report for registration on the above routine, and paragraph "V."
2. If returning students have attended elsewhere since their last attendance in T. C. U. a transcript or statement of standing will be required.

III. BRITE COLLEGE OF THE BIBLE STUDENTS

1. All graduate students in religion are to complete registration procedure June 7, in the office of Dean Snogdrass in Brite College of the Bible.

IV. GRADUATE STUDENTS

1. Graduate students entering T. C. U. for the first time must clear application and transcript requirements with Dean A. T. DeGroot not later than June 4.
2. All students registering for graduate credit must have matriculation card signed by Dean DeGroot.
3. Registration is held both during the day and evening periods outlined on this instruction sheet. The alphabetical order need not be observed.

V. TO REGISTER

1. Begin at the South entrance, main floor of the Science Building.
2. Next, go to the Library, get your counselor's help with course selections, have the various departments approve these selections, then have your Major Professor and Dean approve your cards.
3. Veterans attending under the G. I. Bill (World War II or Korean) will go to Room 209 in the Administration Building.
4. Go to the Business Office.
5. Get books at University Book Store.

VI. EVENING COLLEGE STUDENTS

1. Students registering exclusively in the Evening College will report to the Science Building, 6:00 to 9:00 p. m., Monday, June 7.
2. Students who take part of their work in day classes and who must register for one class in the Evening College will follow the routine outlined for day students.
3. Evening College students who now plan to enter the day school must contact the Registrar's Office.
4. Evening College classes will begin Tuesday, June 8.

VII. FURTHER INFORMATION

1. Classes will begin Tuesday, June 8.
2. Adds, drops, changes may be processed June 9.
3. The last day to register is June 11.
