

T.C.U. SPANISH FIESTA, MAY 8, 1956

The Department of Foreign Languages of Texas Christian University, in co-operation with the Spanish Department of Paschal High School, will sponsor a Spanish Fiesta of plays and music on May 8 (Tuesday), at 7:30 P.M. in the Student Center Ballroom of T.C.U.

Students of Spanish at Paschal High School who took part in the state-wide Pan American Forum contests in Austin on April 25 and 26 will present a play, Rigoberto, by Armando Mooock, adapted by Miss Louise Bomar, teacher of Spanish at Paschal High. Two musical numbers, also presented at the Pan American Forum, will be presented.

Students from the Texas Christian University Spanish Department will present two plays from the original texts by the Quintero brothers: Mafiana de Sol, one of the best known of modern Spanish one-act plays, and a comical skit, Esgrima y Amor.

Dean Jerome Moore, of the Add-Ran College of Arts and Sciences, will speak on "Student Interchange between Texas and Mexico."
