Text from Meteorite exhibit:

Four meteorites were found in Fayette Co. at the turn of the century. The first was found in 1988 near Bluff and weighed 280 lbs. Shown here are the second, weighing 17 1/2 lbs., and third weighing 12 lbs., that were found in January 1900 near Swiss Alp in Fayette Co. Later the same year a fourth weighing 2 3/4 lbs. was found in the same area. All four meteorites were found in a straight line several miles long.
