We are marking the farm on which it was found in red. South 1/2 of Section 112, Block 1 A.B. & M..

As to the one that is supposed to have fallen near the Aiken School house we have found no one that can tell us anything definitely but Mr. W.J. Klinger of Plainview, Texas tells us that some years back he was in a museum in Denver Colorado where a Dr. Nunning had a Meteorite about the size of a twelve quart bucket that he had bought years back from someone east of Plainview. Possibly from some Ranch hand for practically nothing so we think there might be some connection there.
