Dear Rotarian Amon:

The Executive Committee, International Boys' Week, in recognition of your outstanding services to the community, have appointed you Chairman of the Honorary Committee for 1926.

This chairmanship carries with it absolutely no responsibilities. We want no money and we are asking for no service whatever. You will probably recognize this, addressed especially to you as rather an unusual statement, especially in view of the fact that in most civic matters you are looked upon as the source from whence comes probably the largest amount of money as well as the greatest amount of service.

For your information, Boys' Week in Fort Worth this year will be celebrated on a scale we believe exceeding anything in the country. We have been granted low round trip passenger rates from Texas points of one and one-half fare. Towns within a radius of 200 miles of Fort Worth will be pretty well plastered with Fort Worth Boys' Week propaganda and we believe that our publicity campaign has been mapped out in the most comprehensive manner possible. In our parade you will see from the reviewing stand more than twenty thousand boys in the line of march, together with upwards of fifty floats and probably no less than thirty-two or thirty-three boys' bands from various sections.
