Dear Mr. Mounig -

At this writing, the following
Meteorite seems to be for sale. The price is
still uncertain - the owner hasn't fixed it
firmly. It is a slice from Blouetia
Mountain, irregular in shape but roughly
measuring at maximum $11\frac{1}{2}'' \times 7'' \times \frac{3}{4}''$.

Dr. Manson at AMNH has seen it and
authenticated the locality. Curiously, it
is the adjacent slice to theirs which is
somewhat smaller. The weight is 4590 grams.
About 60% of the surface of one side shows
good Widmannstätten figures, but the
whole surface has oxidized somewhat and
Dr. Manson thought it should be repolished.

I don't know how interested you would be
