Dear Mr. Monnig;

Indeed, I have not forgotten the conversation we had last year and have been wondering if I should write to you and make some firm plans.

The site of the Goose Lake fall is about 400 miles, a good 8 hour drive from here. However, the last time I went there, we left here at about 5:00 am and arrived at the site about 2 in the afternoon, with plenty of time for wandering around the site and picking up fragments.

I suggest as a starter that we leave San Francisco, early on the morning of October 28, we have 3 or 4 hours at the site that afternoon, then return to Alturas or one of the small towns along the way and stay the night. We then leave early on the morning of October, 29, Sunday, getting back to San Francisco by midafternoon. If you must be back in Fort Worth on Monday, you could nicely make reservations Sunday evening, getting to your destination before midnight. Sat

Depending on the activities Friday night, we might also consider leaving here after the sessions, drive say 4 hours, stay the night in Redding or Red Bluff and then leave from there the next morning. In any case there is some flexibility which we can discuss later.

I will look forward to this trip, for I have not been there this year, and I like to get up there every year. Did you see the article in NATURE by Axon on the Goose Lake Fragments?

My car is in good shape, so you need have no thought of transportation up there.
