In checking thru one of my files several days ago, I see that Mr. Bunch once wrote me he was going to get in touch with you and check this stone, but I am not sure he ever did.

If you have a rock that may be a meteorite, we would be definitely interested in it, and would appreciate hearing from you with any details. I think Mr. Parks said the inside of your stone was quite soft, which would be unusual for meteorites, the some are quite crumbly. They are always solid--no gas or bubble holes.
