As a labor of love I am trying to establish any facts I can about a stony meteorite in the effects of the late Dr. J. E. Hawkins of Baylor University at Waco.

It is a grayish-brown stone some 8 to 10 inches long and about 4 inches in other dimensions; it has not been put on scales but I would guess it weighs some 10-12 pounds.

I find his family knows practically nothing about where he got it, or when, and I have written more remote relatives or others to whom they have referred me, but I can not establish anything definitely.

Mr. R. A. Smith, formerly of Turkey but now at Canyon, suggested I contact you.

Any light you can shed on the matter will be much appreciated.
