in one end of a bluff; San Saba Co? The date seems to have been near the 1917, Oct. 1 fireball, and this is prob what they saw. The best witnes is <u>Gabiel</u>, who is now camped on Deer Creek somewhere in or near SW Llano Co. Willis is another but less reliable witness. O'G is going to be with Henry Lindsey near Travis Peak for a while.
