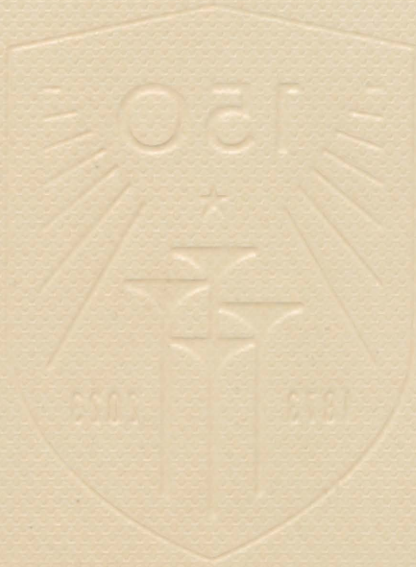

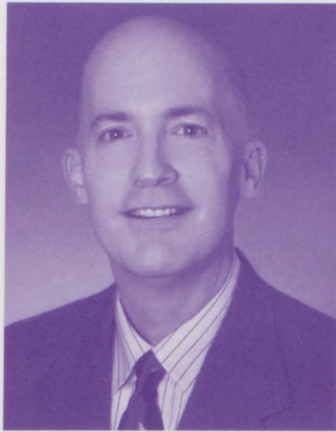
In Chancellor Boschini's 20 years at TCU, he has earned a renowned reputation for his visionary leadership. He and his executive team are championed for their commitment to developing TCU's unmatched student experience, academic excellence, athletic strength, and the unique culture of connection that sets TCU apart.

TCU is a world-class, values-centered private university with a legacy of creating ethical leaders who shape and improve the world for the greater good. TCU continues its same founding spirit of inclusiveness by welcoming students, faculty and staff from diverse backgrounds in Fort Worth and across the globe.

TCU consistently ranks among the top universities and colleges in the nation, including being ranked by *U.S. News & World Report* as a top 100 national university for 14 years in a row. The university's most exceptional achievements over the last two decades include: the establishment of the Anne

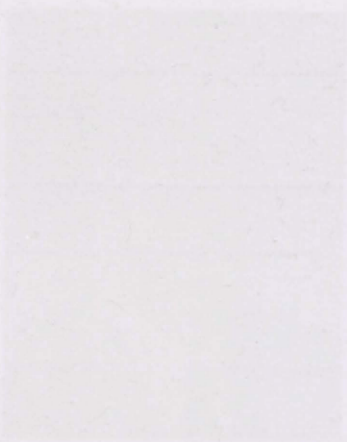

DANIEL W. PULLIN PRESIDENT

Daniel W. Pullin begins his tenure as Texas Christian University President during a season of historic moments as TCU celebrates its Sesquicentennial and looks ahead to the next 150 years of educating students, developing leaders and enhancing its national reputation as a world-class, values-centered university.

Working with Chancellor Victor J. Boschini, Jr. and other senior leadership at TCU, President Pullin infuses operational expertise and strategic planning with innovation to support the university's growth, academic mission, vision and values. In addition to operational management, his executive leadership and experience will support and expand TCU's focus on key goals, including academic excellence and reputation, student engagement and culture of belonging. President Pullin is an energetic leader committed to TCU's community of students, faculty, staff, donors and alumni. In addition to serving as President, Pullin is a professor of entrepreneurship and innovation in the Neeley School of Business.

After joining TCU in 2019 as the John V. Roach Dean of the Neeley School of Business, Neeley experienced dynamic faculty and staff growth and curriculum innovation; earned increased national visibility and rankings; realized



development success; built community and civic engagement; and implemented an unmistakable commitment to inclusive excellence. Prior to joining TCU, Pullin was the dean of the Price College of Business at the University of Oklahoma, where he also served as university vice president.

Throughout his career, President Pullin has successfully blended his experience in higher education with an early foundation in world-renowned business organizations. Before transitioning to higher education, he worked for global consultancy McKinsey & Company and the private equity firm Hicks Muse Tate & Furst and its portfolio companies.

Honored as one of *Fort Worth, Inc.*'s 400 Most Influential People in Fort Worth and *D CEO* magazine's 500 Most Influential Business Leaders in North Texas, President Pullin has won several awards for teaching, innovation in business and academic integrity. He earned his undergraduate degrees from the University of Oklahoma and MBA from Harvard Business School before returning to OU to earn a Juris Doctor.

President Pullin's two sons, Halsey and Parker, are avid TCU fans and enjoy attending athletic and campus events with their dad.

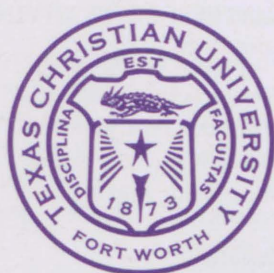

INTERNATIONAL FLAGS

The 19 flags displayed on the arena floor represent the countries of our 30 international students who are receiving their diplomas today. The following countries are represented: Australia, China, Denmark, France, Guatemala, India, Italy, Republic of Korea, Nicaragua, Nigeria, Panama, Philippines, Saudi Arabi, Somalia, Sri Lanka, Turkey, Ukraine, United Kingdom and Vietnam.

THE UNIVERSITY MACE

The mace is a symbol of the strength of a university. In medieval times, the mace was a weapon designed to protect the dignitary in a procession. Academia borrowed that tradition from royalty, designating it as a symbol of the power of a university and of its leader – power shared with the faculty. Maces, similar in appearance to ancestral weaponry, usually are constructed of wood or metal and may have symbols of the institution worked into the design. Texas Christian University's mace was created to commemorate the inauguration of Chancellor Michael R. Ferrari in 1999. TCU staff member, Robert Kramer, a master carver, made the shaft of the mace. It is fashioned from a wooden beam from the first building constructed at AddRan Male and Female College in Thorp Spring, Texas. The head of the mace was created by international sculptor and TCU parent, Seppo Aarnos, and proudly bears the horned frog, adopted in 1897 as the university's mascot. An amethyst at the center of the head glows with the colors purple for royalty and white for purity.

THE FLAME OF KNOWLEDGE

The Flame of Knowledge represents a university's dedication to learning and expanding knowledge. It is a symbol of wisdom, knowledge and power, with fire being a common metaphor for these concepts. Texas Christian University's Flame of Knowledge was created by Fort Worth artisan Raymond C. Huyge to celebrate the University's 150th anniversary. It is fashioned out of live oak with a red oak insert, which are two types of trees that can be found on campus. The flame itself is made of cypress with gold veins to reflect light, and it sits on a purple heart wood base that also holds the University Mace, a permanent companion to the Flame of Knowledge.

The design incorporates three brass bands on the shaft to symbolize the University's three campus locations, a penny from 1873 embedded in the base of the handle, and wood from a historic campus tree. Inset brass university seals can be found on the front and back.

TRADITION OF ACADEMIC DRESS

The history of academic dress dates from at least the twelfth century, when long gowns were needed for warmth in the unheated buildings used by medieval scholars. In England, both Oxford and Cambridge made academic dress a matter of university surveillance, and both institutions regulated which colors and trim could be used by faculty and students. In May 1895, representatives from American institutions of higher learning met at Columbia University and formulated a "code

of academic dress," which has generally been followed since that time, although some revisions were initiated in 1932 and in 1960.

The dress code recommended that gowns for the bachelor's degree should be worn closed and should have pointed sleeves. Gowns for the master's degree can be worn open or closed, but their sleeves are oblong in shape with open wrists. Gowns worn by those holding the doctoral degree also can be worn open or closed and feature bell-shaped sleeves.

Gowns from different institutions vary in color, but most are black. Neither the bachelors' nor the masters' gowns feature trim, but doctoral gowns are faced down the front with black velvet and hold three bars of the same fabric across the sleeves. Sometimes these facings and sleeve-bars are velvet of the color distinctive of the subject to which the degree pertains, thus agreeing in color with the binding or edging of the hood appropriate to the particular doctoral degree of the wearer.

Hoods are to be of the same color and material as the gowns and are lined with the official color(s) of the college or university conferring the degree. Bindings or edgings for the hoods display the color distinctive of the subject to which the degree pertains. Bachelors' hoods are three feet in length; masters' hoods are three and one-half feet in length; doctoral hoods measure four feet in length.

For all academic purposes, including the trimmings of gowns, hoods and tassels, the colors associated with the different academic fields are as follows:

With just 13 students, they opened the doors of AddRan Male and Female College in 1873, one of the first coed institutions west of the Mississippi.

The school officially became Texas Christian University in 1902. Eight years later, a campus fire forced TCU to find a new location. Fort Worth's city leaders felt a college might soften their rowdy "cow town" reputation. The promise of 50 acres, \$200,000 and streetcar service sealed the deal on Fort Worth becoming TCU's permanent home.

TCU and Fort Worth enjoyed a successful partnership of growth, mutual enrichment and community throughout the 20th century, and the new millennium brought unprecedented cultural and physical progress to the university.

TCU is now a top national university in one of the country's most populous metropolitan areas. Through decades of strategic planning, vision and generosity, we've developed programs and a campus that will address the needs of the coming century.

Today, students hailing from 76 nations and representing more than 60 faiths enjoy the benefits of a Big 12 school with excellent academics delivered in a uniquely personal setting. The Horned Frog family includes approximately 12,785 current students who are still seeking an empowering educational atmosphere, 3,400 faculty and staff who are dedicated to supporting our thriving academic community, and a worldwide network of more than 100,000 living alumni.



As caring global citizens, the TCU community looks back on its history and learns from it, with a renewed commitment to work together to shape a brighter future.

Years ago, our beloved institution was created as an enriching place for men and women of character to acquire a liberal arts education while leading the way for the greater good.
