I have a portion of a stony meteorite, weighing approx. seven ounces. This is part of a meteorite which fell in Maziba, Uganda, East Africa. This is one of four pieces sent me by the Geological Survey of Uganda. I have donated one specimen to the American Museum of Natural History and one to Dr. Henderson of the National Museum for study.

The meteorite fall was observed, and a report was sent me along with the specimens. The report was published in England, and full details of the report will be sent, along with the analysis.
