Dear Mr. Hininger:

I have your inquiry about the McKinney, Texas, find of 1870.

I cannot say that I have established the place of find definitively, but one old lady said it was near the NW corner of the Foot ranch, and 8 or 10 years ago there was still a church, store, etc., at this little place of Foot. Right there we retrieved a small stone fragment which I have presumed to be McKinney but have never checked by cutting. Several subsequent efforts to locate more material failed.

I quote the following from a paper read at one of the meetings of The Meteoritical Society but not yet offered for publication:

"...the McKinney, Texas, meteorites were probably found near the former settlement of Foot, about  $5\frac{1}{2}$  miles west of McKinney. Their co-ordinate number would be 0967332, and the point of find was very close to  $96^{\circ} 43'$  W.,  $33^{\circ} 12'$  N....."
