The information comes to me second-handed that Mr. Walter White, a High School teacher in Barnham, Texas, has been showing his class specimens of the meteorite which he recovered. I am unable to locate Barnham but was told it was close to Dallas. All this information comes indirectly from Dr. John Allan of Dallas and I assume you know who he is.

If I can be of any assistance in examining material or if you think I should come down and spend time running this one down, let me know?

Dr. Hardy called the other day and had maps of the area around where the Moab, Utah specimen was reported to have been found. Using your information and Hardy's knowledge of the country, we put the location in Garfield County, and the coordinates of the place are approximately 38° 04 N, 110° 22 W.

Now that the pressure is off somewhat, I am going to examine that iron and get out a report on it. Hardy thinks there is a Canyon Diablo specimen missing from some of the Park Service Museums and asked if I believed this could be that individual. From what I know about this iron, it is unlike the Canyon Diablo specimens but I could know much more if I studied it a little more.

Have you any information that is new about it?
