September 22, 1935.

We had two  
Division reviews last

Washington D.C. Before (17)  
reviews we have to work  
cleaning mules, shellacking harnesses,  
polishing brass, cleaning carts  
etc. besides that we have to  
polish our own equip. such

for soldiers but they look

were about 5000 soldiers and  
hundreds of trucks, horses,
