

INSTRUCTIONS

1. This pass is good until revoked during normal off-duty hours. Normal off-duty hours are: Weekdays, between retreat and reveille; Weekends, from noon Saturday to reveille Monday; Legal Holidays, from retreat the day before to reveille the day after in mid-week, and consecutive with weekends.
2. This pass is good until revoked during special off-duty hours because the holder is on duty during normal off-duty hours.
3. Soldier will keep this pass in his possession at all times while outside his station boundaries.
