Dear Dr. Henderson:

You are possibly aware that there are being offered commercially some small irons reportedly from Nutwood Down (I believe it is written Nut Wood), Northern Territory. Australia.

There was some information that they fell in 1966 but this is obviously wrong as to the pieces I have seen since they are quite well oxidized. They look like crater irons in being rather ragged and torn like Henrybury's, which, indeed, they greatly resemble.

Maybe I ought to know about these but I don't. Any light you can shed on the supposed occurrence will be appreciated.
