

INSTRUCTION SHEET

ADMISSION:

BRING THE ENCLOSED NUMBERED CARD to Commencement. It will be pinned on your gown to insure proper place in processional lines.

ASSEMBLY:

Your Place of assembling will be determined by your number.

Line I (numbers 1 - 108) will form at Training Room Door at south end of West Grandstand.

Line II (numbers 109 - 216) will form at Ticket Office Door at south end of West Grandstand.

Line III (numbers 217 - 432) will form at Press Box elevator door in the direct center beneath the West Grandstand.

Line IV (numbers 433 - 650) will form at Portal 13 at north end of West Grandstand.

LINE OF MARCH:

Dr. Everett is the marshal to lead Line I (numbers 1 - 108) to position on the field. Please note on chart the route of march.

Dr. Watson will guide Line II (numbers 109 - 216) onto field.

Dr. Herrick will lead Line III (numbers 217 - 432) onto field.

Dr. Wible will lead Line IV (numbers 433 - 650) onto field.

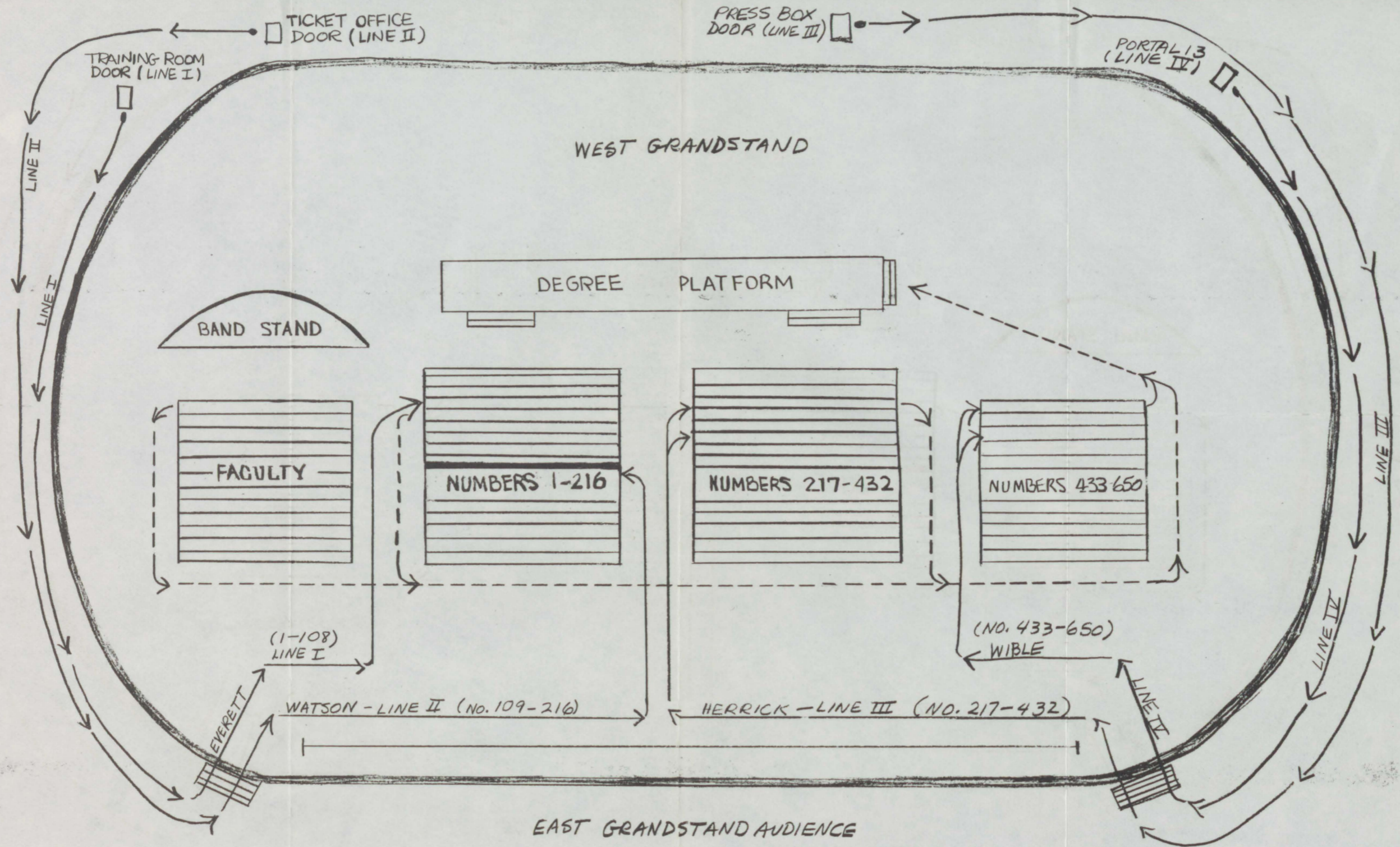
NOTE: Broken lines indicate your route from seats to degree platform. After receiving your degree return to your seat. A marshal will direct you.

ACADEMIC DECORUM:

During the Commencement program women do not remove their caps at any time. Men remove their caps only during prayer and the singing of the Alma Mater; then they immediately replace them. Candidates for graduate degrees are permitted to wear their academic hoods at the Commencement exercises. Recipients of the bachelor's degree will wear the tassel on the right front side of cap before degrees are conferred; on way back to seat, shift tassel to the left.

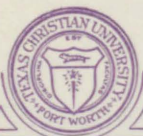
